1. P. G. Course in all departments phase wise.
2. Girls' hostel upgradation and construction of boys' hostel.
3. College canteen upgradation.
4. Renovation of boundary Wall.
5. Improvement of drinking water facilities.
6. Construction of new car shade and cycle stand.
7. Introduction of new subjects of science stream in undergraduate level.
8. Introduction of honours course in Sociology and History.
9. Self - financing Course : Computer education for all with CEC, Naharkatia Centre in PPP mode will be started from the next academic session.
10. Collaboration with other inter and intra state Higher Education Institutions for students and faculty exchange. The process has already been stated with two institutes - Deomali College of Arunachal Pradesh and Sonari Commerce College, Sonari, Assam.
11. Collaboration with feeder school. The process is in final stage with Ushapur H.S. School.
12. Research: The college has made a communication with Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya, Nagoan, assam for establishing a Research Centre within its campus. A plan is also there to establish a Buddhist Research Centre in association with the Namphake Buddhist Monastery, Naharkatia.
13. Expansion for Digital class Room & ICT/Smart class room.
14. Sports facilities: Besides the existing facilities which include playground, volleyball complex, multi gym etc., the college has a plan to construct a modern Indoor Stadium.
15. Ethnic Museum : For exhibiting the socio – cultural heritage and tradition of the ethnic peoples of the locality, the college is planning to set up an Ethnic Museum.
16. Resource Mobilization: For resource mobilization the college has plan to set up a mini market complex in front of the college along roadside as well as horticulture and poultry farm in the vacant land within the campus.
17. Students Support: Plan to support to needy students financially and providing other



amenities. The career guidance and placement cell will be more vibrant.




