

# Naharkatiya College at a glance

Naharkatiya College, Naharkatiya Assam was established on 2<sup>nd</sup>August, 1964. Eminent Scholar and Litterateur Pandit Ram Prasad Chaliha was its founder Principal. From its modest inception as an Arts College, Naharkatiya College has now developed into its present statute of a famous full fledged degree college imparting higher education in Arts and Commerce stream. It is affiliated to the Dibrugarh University and registered under 2(F) and 12(B) of the University Grant Commission Act, 1956.

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
College has the distinction of being assessed and accredited by the NAAC in two college has of accreditationand was placed in Grade B in a four point scale. The college has collebrated its Golden Jubilee in the year 2014 with a long and continuous program. The college has 10 departments of Arts and Commerce with facilities for honours courses in almost all subjects. From the academic year, 2019-20 college has implemented the CBCS chrriculum of Dibrugarh University. To enable the students to cope with the challenges of the modern digital society, the college has established a Digital Knowledge Centre and a Digital Library with e- learning resources. A Course in Computer Application is also introduced for the benefit of the students. Apart from the general courses, the College has introduced the Ibepartment of Information Technology to educate the students with modern computer skills. Naharkatiya College has Centres of two distance learning courses, viz, DODL (Directorate of Open and Distance Learning, Dibrugarh University) and KKHSOU (Krishna Kanta Handique Sate Open University, Guwahati). The college has developed its own unique philosophy and vision, mission and programs of action.

## Namrup College at a glance

Namrup College is located on the foothills of Patkai hills in the Dibrugarh district of Assam. It was established in 1973 to cater to the need of higher education of the neighbouring villages and tea gardens. The College with the faculties of Arts and Science qualified itself for the inclusion under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956 on 14th February 1997 and Section (B) on 4th April 2000. The college is affiliated to Dibrugarh University, Assam.

The college has 14 departments of Arts and Science with facilities for honours courses in almost all subjects. From the academic year, 2019-20 college has implemented the CBCS curriculum of Dibrugarh University. The College has already been reaccredited by NAAC in two cycle of accreditation in 2004 and 2011, respectively and in the second cycle of reaccreditation it was accredited with Grade-B at CGPA-2.27.

Namrup College conducts outreach programmes and different extension activities for the benefit of students and the society. College offers certificate courses on mushroom cultivation, vermin compost production and cutting and tailoring. From this academic session onwards, we are planning to introduce some need base add on courses.

- 2. To provide an atmosphere of sharing expertise and knowledge among the students and the facilities between the two parties.


## Article-2

## **Areas of Collaboration**

Department of Economics, Naharkatiya College and Department of Economics, Namrup College hereby agree to encourage academic cooperation through faculty exchange in the furtherance of the advancement of teaching and learning as stated below:

Both parties will honour their individual rights in performing their day to day academic activities. The collaborative activities under this agreement will be worked out on a case to case basis without deferring the Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) of both the parties.

## Article-5

## **Scope of Cooperation**

The both parties agree to cooperation programmes including the following


- 1. Exchange on best practices.

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## Article-7

## Financial Arrangement

- 1. Any cooperation under the MOU is subject to the availability of funding sources and approved by relevant authorities.
  - 2. Any specific project of joint interest will be detailed in a separate agreement including financial and programme specific arrangement.

## Article-8

## **Confidentiality**

In the event that other party wishes to disclose any data and or information supplied in or resulted from the implementation of the MOU disclosing party shall have prior written consent from the other party.

#### Article-9

#### **Limitation of Activities**

The parties shall ensure that their personnel engaged in the activities under this MOU shall engage only in activities unde3r the framework of this MOU with respect to national law and regulation of the respective countries.

#### Article-10

## **Settlement of Disputes**

Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MOU shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation between the parties.

#### Article-11

## **Amendment**

- 1) This MOU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of the parties and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MOU.
  - 2) Such amendment or revision shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the parties

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## Article-12

## **Duration**

This memorandum of understanding will be for five years signing date year of MOU Academic activities will be for five years i.e. from 2023 to 2028.


